exists, simply serve it.*

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -s [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -l [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -d

RewriteRule ^.*\$ - [NC,L]

Assets versioning

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-d

RewriteRule ^(\.+)\.(\d+)\.(\.js|.css|.png|.jpg|.gif)\$ \$1.\$3 [L]

Ignore static content and don't redirect it to the app.

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_URI} ^(css|.js|.img|.assets)/ [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} \.(\.js|.map|.css|.ico|.gif|.jpg|.png|.eot|.svg|.ttf|.woff)\$

RewriteRule ^.*\$ - [NC,L]

The following rewrites all other queries to index.php.

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_URI}::\$1 ^(/.+)(.+)::\2\$

RewriteRule ^(.*) - [E=BASE:%1]

RewriteRule ^(.*)\$ %{ENV:BASE}index.php [NC,L]
